# **Prospectus for Admission into “Master of Physiotherapy Courses” under Competent Authority Quota/State Quota seats for the Academic Year 2025-26.**

## **REGULATIONS:**

The following are the Regulations for admission into Master of Physiotherapy courses under Competent Authority Quota (CQ Seats) in all affiliated Colleges to Dr.NTR UHS in the State of Andhra Pradesh for the academic year 2025-26.

### **1. NUMBER OF SEATS UNDER COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA**

- 1.1 The number of colleges and seats for admission into MPT courses for the academic year 2025-26 are Annexed VII
- 1.2 **In case any new Colleges/Courses are affiliated to the University for starting the MPT Courses for the academic year 2025-26, those seats will also be filled up. NO FURTHER NOTIFICATION WILL BE ISSUED.**
- 1.3 The selections will be made to the colleges subject to affiliation for the academic year 2025-26.
- 1.4 The details of the seats available and Seat matrix under ‘Competent authority Quota’ for the Academic Year 2025-26 will be displayed in the University website at the time of counseling.

### **2. ELIGIBILITY:**

**The Candidate should be an Indian National and should satisfy Local or Non-Local status as per G.O.P. 646, Education Dept., dated 10-07-1979 and must satisfy the eligibility criteria as noted below:**

- 2.1 **Educational Qualification:** The candidate should have passed BPT Course with minimum of 55% aggregate marks and 5% relaxation of marks for SC and ST candidates.
- 2.2 **Age:** Candidates should not have completed 45 years of age as on 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year of admission. For candidates belonging to SC and ST the maximum age limit shall be 48 years.
- 2.3 **Internship:** Candidates who passed BPT degree of Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences or equivalent Degree and have completed internship on or before **05.12.2025** are eligible to apply subject to the fulfillment of all other conditions stipulated in these Regulations.

**NOTE:** If a candidate is found to have concealed any information regarding this matter the application of such candidate is liable to be cancelled. Further disciplinary action will be taken by the University against him/her.

### **3. RESERVATION IN FAVOUR OF THE LOCAL CANDIDATES:**

Admission to 85% of the seats shall be reserved in favour of the local candidates in relation to the local area as provided in A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission) order, 1974 and definitions of local area and local candidate as notified by the Govt. of A.P. for PG Medical and Dental Courses vide G.O.Ms.No.83, dt. 23-07-2025 of HM & FW (C1) Dept., Govt. of A.P have been adopted for the purpose of Local Area and Local candidate for admission into MPT Courses. The contents of G.O. Ms.No.83 are reproduced here under:

#### **4 LOCAL AREA:**

- 4.1 **Andhra University Area:** The part of the State comprising the erstwhile Districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur and Prakasam shall be regarded as the local area for the purposes of admission to the Andhra Pradesh Professional Institutions i.e. Post graduate Medical and Dental Professional courses and to any other educational institutions (other than a State-wide University or State-wide Educational Institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.
- 4.2 **Sri Venkateswara University Area:** The part of the State comprising the erstwhile Districts of Anantapur, Kurnool, Chittoor, Cuddapah and Nellore shall be regarded as the local area for the purposes of admission to the Andhra Pradesh Professional Institutions i.e. Post graduate Medical and Dental Professional courses and to any other educational institutions (other than a State-wide University or State-wide Educational Institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.

#### **5. LOCAL CANDIDATES:**

- 5.1 A candidate for admission to any course of study shall be regarded as local candidate in relation to a local area.
  - i) If he/she has studied in an educational institution(s) in such local area for a period of not less than four consecutive academic year ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared in the relevant qualifying examination  
or
  - ii) where, during the whole or any part of the four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or, as the case may be, first appeared in relevant qualifying examination, he/she has resided in that local area for a period of not less than four years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination in which he/she appeared or, as the case may be, first appeared.

5.2 A candidate for admission to any course of study who is not regarded as a local candidate under sub regulation above in relation to any local area shall:

- i) If he / she has studied in an educational institution in the state for a period of not less than seven (7) consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination be regarded as a local candidate in relation to:

  - a) Such local area where he/she studied for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years;
  - b) Where the period of his/her study in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he /she studied last in such equal periods;

**(or)**

- ii) If during the whole or any part of the 7 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, if he/she has not studied in the educational institution in any local area, but he/she has resided in the State during the whole of the said period of not less than four years be regarded as a local candidate in relation to:

  - a) Such local area where he/she resided for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years;

**(or)**

  - b) Where the period of his/her residence in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he/she resided last in such equal periods;

5.3 Local status certificate issued by MRO through online for claiming as AP local as per Circular Nos.4136/SPF&MC/2015-5, dated.08.08.2016, 4136/SPF&MC/2015-13, dt. 20.11.2017 & G.O.Ms.No.129, dated 28-10-2019 of General Administration Dept. No offline certificates will be considered.

**5.4. EXPLANATIONS:** For the Purpose of this regulation.

- i) “Educational Institution” means a University or any educational institution recognized by the State Government, a University or other competent authority.
- ii) “Relevant qualifying examination” in relation to admission to any course of study, means the examination, a pass in which the minimum educational qualification for admission to such course of study.

**Note:** The relevant qualifying examination for admission into MPT courses is BPT examination. The question whether the candidate is a local candidate or not will be determined with reference to his/her first appearance in the final BPT examination.

- iii) a) In reckoning the consecutive academic years during which a candidate has studied any period of interruption of his/her study by a reason of his/her failure to pass any examination shall be disregarded.
- b) Any period of his/her study in a State-wide University or a State-wide educational institution shall be disregarded
- iv) The question whether any candidate for admission into any course of study has resided in any local area shall be determined with reference to the places where the candidate actually resided and not with reference to the residence of his/her parent or guardian.

**5.5.** If a local candidate in respect of a local area is not available to fill up any seat reserved or allotted in favour of local candidate in respect of that local area, such seat shall be filled as if it had not been reserved.

**5.6. The following categories of candidates are eligible to apply for admission to the remaining 15% of AP Unreserved seats.**

- i) All the candidates eligible to be declared as local candidates of two local areas of State of Andhra Pradesh.
- ii) Candidates, who have resided in the State of Andhra Pradesh for a total period of ten years excluding periods of study outside the State, or either of whose parents have resided in the State of Andhra Pradesh for a total period of ten years excluding periods of employment outside the state.
- iii) Candidates who are children of parents who are in employment of the State of Andhra Pradesh or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and Educational Institutions other similar quasi Public Institutions within the State of Andhra Pradesh.
- iv) Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State of Andhra Pradesh or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and Educational Institutions recognized by the Government or University or other Competent Authority and similar quasi Government Institutions within the State of Andhra Pradesh."
- v) Candidates, who are employed in the State Government undertakings, Public Sector, Corporations, local bodies, Universities and other similar quasi-public institutions with in the State of Andhra Pradesh.

vi) Candidates who are spouses of the local candidates as per rule.

**Note:** Relevant scanned original certificates must be uploaded along with application in respect of their claim for 15% Unreserved seats. In respect of proof of 10 years residence, the certificate should be obtained from the Revenue Authorities and the issuing Officer shall not be below the rank of Andhra Pradesh Mandal Revenue Officer / Tahsildar.

## 6. RESERVATION:

6.1 a) Seats of MPT Courses are reserved for SC, ST and BC sub groups as detailed below, which are called vertical reservations.

b) As per Memo No.2825083/C1/2025, dt.23-05-2025 of HM&FW (C1) Dept., Govt. of AP the reservations provided to the three groups of Scheduled Castes shall be within fifteen (15%) of reservation prescribed to Scheduled Castes as follows:-

6.2 As per Memo No.2832690/C1/2025, dt.15-07-2025 of HM&FW (C1) Dept., Govt. of AP the implementation of SC sub-classification when availability of seats are less, has been examined in consultation with Social welfare Department and Government after careful examination of the matter, hereby clarify that:

- 1) When particular seat is not available, the rules with regard to sub- classification specify that if Group-I eligible candidate for admission is not available it shall be filled in by the candidate belonging to Group-II and so on and so forth.
- 2) In cases where the availability of seats is limited/less, the Competent authority for admissions may take appropriate administrative decisions regarding net group adjustments among the sub-groups of Scheduled Castes (SCs). This should be done by duly following the established procedure for net group adjustments as is practiced among the Backward Classes (BC) sub-groups. Such decisions must be placed before the selection committee for admissions, by justified reasons taking the spirit of sub-classification of Scheduled Castes.

### **6.3 CERTIFICATION OF CASTE:**

- 6.3.1 As per Memo No.2832690/C1/2025, dt.21-07-2025 of HM&FW (C1) Dept., Govt. of A.P., **the Caste certificates issued by the Government of A.P will only be considered for admissions.**
- 6.3.2 Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Backward Class candidates shall in support of their claim, have to furnish latest Integrated Caste Certificate with Barcode obtained from Government of AP in the prescribed form issued by the Concerned Authority. If the certificate is not in the prescribed form, candidates will not be considered for selection under the reserved quota.
- 6.3.3 Latest Permanent caste certificate (issued by Competent Authority of Govt. of Andhra Pradesh only). **Caste certificates of other States will not be accepted** & in such cases the applied candidate will be considered under General category only.
- 6.3.4 Candidates claiming reservations under SC/ST/BC categories shall submit a permanent social status certificate mentioning the sub- caste in case of Scheduled Castes/ Backward Castes and sub-tribe or sub-group (in case of Scheduled Tribes) issued by the Competent Authority of Government of Andhra Pradesh only. The social status of SC/ST/BC candidates shall be subject to the scrutiny as per G.O.Ms.No.58 SW (J) Dept. Dt 12-5-97 & as per G.O.Ms.No.7, Social Welfare (CV), dt.18-04-2025.
- 6.3.5 In case of Minority candidates, the Minority certificate issued by Minorities Welfare Department, Government of AP to be furnished in support of their claim

## **7 RESERVATION FOR PERSONS WITH BENCHMARK DISABILITY (PwBD):**

- 7.1 Out of the available seats for admission by the Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, 5% shall be reserved for the Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD) in each categories of OC, SC, ST, BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D and BC-E as per Government of India guidelines as per the availability of seats.
- 7.2 The candidates seeking the benefit of reservation under PwBD category should enclose a valid disability certificate issued not later than three months (03) prior to submitting his/her application.
- 7.3 The Medical Board constituted by the University will scrutinize/verify the disability certificates as per G.O. MS.No.31, Women development, Child welfare & disabled welfare (DW) department, dated.01.12.2009 and candidates claiming reservation under PwBD quota for conformation of eligibility and the decision of Medical Board specially constituted for the purpose is final and binding on the candidates.
- 7.4 The Medical Board constituted by the University will scrutinize/verify the disability certificates as per the University Guidelines regarding admission of students with "Specified Disabilities" under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 with respect to admission in MPT Courses.

## **8 APPLICATIONS THROUGH ONLINE:**

- 8.1 The on-line application forms will be available on the Website **from 2.00 P.M. on 07-12-2025 to 2.00 P.M. on 15-12-2025**
- 8.2 The candidates are advised to take a print out of the Prospectus from the website <http://drntr.uhsap.in> before proceeding to fill in the correct application form.
  - The candidate should fill the online application form available on the Website with the required data from a desktop/laptop only with internet connection.
  - Candidates are advised to carefully go through the prospectus in detail and, upon confirming their eligibility, proceed to fill in the correct CQ Online Application Form. All required certificates should be kept readily available to ensure accurate and complete submission of information. It may be noted that no request for refund or transfer of fee will be considered in cases where an incorrect application is submitted.

➤ **No new applications shall be entertained beyond the notified cut-off date, and candidates will not be permitted to apply until the completion of Phase-III (Mop-Up) Counselling.**

**8.3 Procedure of filling online application form and payment of fee through online:**

The fee can be paid through Debit card / Credit card or Net Banking.

- a. Read the Notification, Prospectus / Regulations carefully regarding eligibility under local and non-local.
- b. The Registration number which will be sent to the registered mobile after entering the basic details, should be noted for further use. The Registration number should be kept confidential and should not be disclosed to others.
- c. The candidates should fill - in all the correct details in the online application form and shall upload all the requisite documents.

### 10.2 UNIVERSITY FEE:

All the selected candidates shall pay the following University fee at the time of downloading the allotment order through online by Debit card/Credit

## **11. VERIFICATION OF CERTIFICATES:**

11.1 The eligibility of a candidate will be verified basing on the uploaded copies of scanned certificates/ documents. The candidates who are claiming reservation under Special Categories i.e., PwBD, have to watch the University website for further notifications, if any, for scrutiny of original certificates of respective special category.

**Note:** 1. The candidature of the applicant will not be considered for admission into MPT courses if not submitted the online application by uploading the scanned copies of required certificates/documents as per regulations.  
2. The eligibility and community verification will be done basing on the uploaded scanned original certificates.

## **12. MERIT LIST:**

- i. The Provisional Merit Position of the candidates those who have applied through online in response to the notification issued by Dr.NTRUHS for Competent Authority Quota seats into MPT shall be determined by after verification of uploaded certificates by the University and officials of concerned departments as per eligibility rules/ regulations.
- ii. The University will release final merit position of eligible candidates for exercising web Options, after completion of the verification of data and certificates uploaded by the candidates.
- iii. The merit list will be prepared on the marks obtained in BPT group subjects (all subjects) up to two decimal places excluding Computer Sciences and English marks.
- iv. **As the Merit list will be prepared basing on Group subjects, the candidates while filling up of Online application, shall enter the**

**total marks excluding English & Computer Science Marks as the case may be.**

v. In case equality aggregate marks, age shall be taken into consideration and older candidates shall be given higher places in the merit list.

### **13. WEB COUNSELING:-**

**The Notification for exercising web options, procedure and applicable guidelines for admission into MPT courses will be issued separately from time to time. Same application will be considered for all phases of the counselling.**

### **14. ADMISSION RULES:**

- 14.1. The Selected candidates have to download the allotment order from the website after payment of University fee by payment gateway.
- 14.2. The candidate should submit the printout of the filled in online application form, provisional allotment order and original certificates along with one set of attested copies to the Principal of the allotted college at the time of joining for final verification. In case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled.

### **15. FINALITY OF SELECTION:**

All selections made under these Regulations shall be subject to any general regulations or order that may be made by the Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences/ Government of AP from time to time.

#### **15.1 JOINING TIME:**

The selected candidates shall join the institution concerned within the specified date along with the original certificates and documents required. No request shall be entertained for extension of time under any circumstances. Failure to join the course in time shall automatically result in cancellation of the seat.

### **16. VACANCIES:**

Vacancies if any caused due to failure to join or cancellation of admission or demise of the candidate etc., before the closure of admissions, shall be filled by the Admission Committee in accordance with the Regulations.

**17. COMMENCEMENT OF THE COURSE:**

The course shall commence as per the schedule notified

**18. CLOSURE OF ADMISSIONS:**

The Admissions shall be closed on the date as notified by the University

**19. DURATION OF THE COURSE:**

The duration of the course shall be two years.

**20. COURSE OF STUDY:**

The candidates admitted into MPT course shall pursue the study in accordance with the syllabus prescribed by the Academic Senate of University.

**21. MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION:**

English will be the medium of instruction for the subjects of study and for the examination of the MPT Courses.

**22. UNIFORM:**

All the candidates are expected to wear the Uniform on duty prescribed by the respective College

**23. LEAVE:**

Each year students will be permitted to avail 30 days leave. No Post Graduate is allowed to go on leave more than 8 days at a stretch. In case the absence of the candidate availing Medical Leave / Maternity Leave / Any other Leave or unauthorized absence is beyond 30 days in a year the study period of the candidate will be extended to the extent of such period. No other leave is permitted.

**24. DISSERTATION:**

Every candidate pursuing MPT degree course is required to carry out work on a selected research project under the guidance of a recognized postgraduate teacher. The results of such a work shall be submitted in the form of dissertation.

The dissertation is aimed to train a graduate student in research methods and techniques. It includes identification of a problem, formulation of a hypothesis, search and review of literature, getting acquainted with recent

advances, designing a research study, collection of data, critical analysis, comparison of results and drawing conclusions.

Every candidate shall submit to the Registrar of the University in the prescribed proforma, a synopsis containing particulars of proposed dissertation work within six months from the date of commencement of the course on or before the dates notified by the University. The synopsis shall be sent through proper channel.

Such synopsis will be reviewed and the University will register the dissertation topic. No change in the dissertation topic or guide shall be made without prior approval of the University.

Approval of dissertation work is an essential precondition for a candidate to appear in the final University examination. The evaluators apart from the guide out of which either is external/outside the University or other postgraduate college of this University shall value the dissertation.

## **25. BREAK OF STUDY AND READMISSION:**

If a student is absent continuously for a period of 91 days or more and seeks permission to attend the course, his / her application in prescribed format by paying requisite fee in favour of Registrar, Dr NTR UHS payable at Vijayawada shall be forwarded to the University with the recommendation of the Dean/Principal.

### **DEFINITIONS:**

- i. Break of study means any absence more than 3 months during the course of study.
- ii. 3 months for this purpose is a period of 90 days (ninety days) to be recorded from the date of absence irrespective of the number of days in one calendar month.
- iii. For all practical purpose only two types of break of study is allowed.
  - a. Less than 3 months of break (as per definition)
  - b. More than 3 months of break but less than the twice the number of years of study of a particular course.  
Ex: For MBBS/BDS twice the number of years of study is 9 years  
For B.Sc., (Nursing) / Physiotherapy is 8 years.
- iv. If the candidate is on Break of study for two spells in an academic year of a particular course the candidate is deemed to have been discharged from the course of study. **One cannot apply for condonation of the break.**

25.2 i. **Only two spells of break of study** for the entire duration of the course is permitted. During second spell of break of study even if the break of study is less than **90** days, permission must be obtained from the

university and that spell of Break shall also be counted as second spell of break.

- ii. For less than three months of break, the Principal/ Dean of the college can permit to rejoin in to the course under intimation to the university.
- iii. If the break of study is more than three months the candidate has to apply to the university through the Principal/Dean of the college. The University can give permission to the candidate to complete the course within **twice the years of the study** of the particular course.

- i) The period of break of study of the candidate for re-admission of the course shall be calculated from the date of first discontinuance of the course.
- ii) All the Post Graduate students have to execute a declaration at the time of registration with this University in this regard in the prescribed form as in Annexure-V.
- iii) The Principal /Dean of the college concerned shall permit any candidate who is absent for less than three months during the course of study to rejoin the course under intimation to this university. It is the responsibility of the Dean / Principal of the college concerned to ensure that a copy of the order of permission granted by them under intimation to the Vice Chancellor Dr. NTR UHS.

The candidate may be permitted by the Principal/Dean to rejoin in the course of study in which he/she discontinued the course for three months and shall be admitted to the examination after fulfillment of the regulation of this university of the course concerned.

- (iv) The candidate having a break of study for more than three (3) months and above but less than twice the years of the course shall apply of rejoining the course in the prescribed form as in Annexure II by remitting the stipulated fee for condonation of Break of study to the Registrar of this university through the Dean/Principal of the concerned college for issue of necessary permission to rejoin the Course. The concerned Dean / Principal of the college shall not permit any candidate with a Break of Study as stipulated above to rejoin the course without obtaining the prior permission from this University.

If any candidate is permitted by the Dean/Principal of the college concerned without the prior permission from this University, to rejoin the course after the break of study the period of such study shall not be considered as a recognized study and the candidate shall not be permitted to write the University examinations based on such study period.

## **26. AGREEMENT BOND/Discontinuation of course:**

(a) All the candidates joining the MPT course shall execute a bond on nonjudicial stamp paper of value of Rs100/- as prescribed in Annexure V to the regulations to ensure completion of the prescribed period of study. In case, if any candidate wish to discontinue their course due to personnel reasons should pay of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) through DD/ online payment in favour of the Registrar, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada. On receipt of the representation of candidate which forwarded by Principal along with DD, the University shall issue discontinuation orders after due procedures. The Principal of the respective Physiotherapy College shall relieve the candidate on receipt of the discontinuation orders from University.

## **27. COLLEGE REGULATIONS:**

Candidates are required to follow the rules and regulations of the college and should also abide by the regulations of the University. Under any circumstances candidates should not make any correspondence with the higher authorities of Government/Dr. NTR UHS directly without routing through proper channel.

## **28. EXAMINATIONS:**

The candidates shall have to appear for such examinations as prescribed by the University from time to time.

## **29. POWERS OF PRINCIPALS:**

- 29.1 Notwithstanding anything contained in these regulations, the Head of the Institution may, at any time either suo-moto or on an application made by any person, after due and proper enquiry, if she is satisfied that the candidate has furnished incorrect information or enclosed false certificates or fraudulently obtained admission, may, for the reasons to be recorded in writing, by order, cancel his/her admission, provided that no such admission shall be cancelled without giving a reasonable opportunity for showing cause as to why his/her admission should not be cancelled.
- 29.2 Against any such order of the Head of the Institution an appeal shall be with the Registrar of the University.

### **30. POWERS OF DR.NTR UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES:**

Dr.NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada may either suo-moto or on application made to them call for to examine the records relating to any selection or admission or cancellation thereof, made by the concerned authority for the purpose of satisfying themselves as to the correctness, regularity or propriety of such order in relation thereto as they deem fit, including cancellation of the selection already published or admission already made provided that the University may, before cancelling such selection or admission give an opportunity to the authority and to the person effected to show-cause against such cancellation. Dr.NTR UHS has every right to cancel the admission of any candidate without any notice, if the certificates produced by the candidate are found to be fake /false / forged.

**Note: If a candidate is found to have submitted false information such candidate is liable to be disqualified for admission and in case already admitted, the admission will be cancelled. Further disciplinary action against him/her will be initiated by the University as per rules.**

### **31. ANTI RAGGING ACT:**

Ragging is prohibited in the Educational Institutions in the state of AP vide Act.No.26 of 1997, dt.21-08-1997.The Anti Ragging Act is placed on the Website of the University for information.


