ZONAL CME - Department of Obstetrics & Gynaecology

The Dr.NTRUHS Zonal CME 2026 on Theme "CTG - listening to Unborn Language" was organized by the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Narayana Medical College, Nellore on 15 March 2026. The programme brought together faculties and post-graduates from Department of Obstetrics & Gynaecology and Radiology to strengthen clinical understanding about CTG.

The Event commenced with Registration followed by Academic session on "Demystifying the CTG Machine - From Hardware to Heart Beats" delivered by Dr. Deepika. This was followed by an Impactful session on "Baseline to Beats - Foundations of Normal CTG Interpretation" by Dr. B. Prasanna. Her talk focused on simplifying complex concepts and physiology. The Next session featured Dr. Thejaswini who delivered about "NICE GUIDELINES" which included Risk assessment to determine the appropriate level of fetal monitoring. It was followed by interesting session on "Physiology to Practice - Antepartum Fetal Monitoring" by Dr. Hyndavi for early detection of fetal hypoxia to prevent Fetal Morbidity and Mortality.

It was followed by Inaugural Ceremony, graced by dignitaries Dr. Srinivasulu Reddy (Dean, Narayana Medical College & Hospital), Dr. Harish (Additional Medical Superintendent, Narayana Medical College & Hospital), Dr. Viswakumar (Vice-Principal & Medical Education Co-ordinator, Narayana Medical College & Hospital), Dr.B. Prasanna. The Next session featured Dr. Bhanu Sudeep who delivered talk on "Flow tells the story - Fetal Doppler", which is an assessment of survival. Who enlightened on knowledge of Medico-legal Issues and Litigations involved in CTG Interpretation. The next lecture was on topic - "Decelerations, Diagnosis & Decision Making" by Dr. G. Karuna who highlighted various causes of Hypoxia and need for timely intervention. This was followed by interesting lecture on "Intermittent Auscultation vs Continuous Monitoring" by Dr. M. Swetha. Her lecture focussed on Monitoring on basis of Risk assessment.

After lunch - There was Engaging "Post-Graduate Quiz" coordinated by Dr. Indira, Dr. Bhavani and Dr. Sujatha which encouraged active participation and academic engagement of all Post-Graduates. This was followed by "Practical CTG Scenarios" by Dr. Abhigna & Dr. Sindhu Bhargavi where all Post-Graduates tried to answer enthusiastically.
