PULSE POLIO IMMUNISATION PROGRAMME 28 June 2026 - REPORT

As part of the **Statewide Pulse Polio Immunization Programme**, **Narayana Medical College & Hospital** organized the **Pulse Polio Immunization Drive** under the guidance of **Dr. P. Sreenivasulu Reddy, Dean**, with the programme being conducted by the **Department of Paediatrics** in collaboration with the **National Service Scheme (NSS), Narayana Medical College & Hospital**.

Prior to the commencement of the programme, **Dr. P. Sreenivasulu Reddy, Dean**, addressed the media and highlighted the importance of the **Pulse Polio Immunization Programme**, one of the flagship initiatives under the **Universal Immunization Programme (UIP)** of the Government of India, implemented in collaboration with the Government of Andhra Pradesh. He stated that the institution is proud to support this statewide initiative aimed at protecting every child from poliomyelitis. He further informed that **approximately 49 lakh children below five years of age** are expected to receive **two drops of Oral Polio Vaccine (OPV)** across Andhra Pradesh during this round. He also explained that **Pulse Polio booths function on 28 June 2026**, followed by

house-to-house visits from 29 June onwards to ensure that no eligible child is left behind.

The Dean appealed to all parents to bring their children below five years of age to the nearest Pulse Polio booth and reminded everyone that “**Just two drops can protect a child for a lifetime.**” He reiterated the campaign message: “**Do Boond Zindagi Ki – Every Child, Every Time.**”

As part of the awareness activities, an **Awareness Rally** was conducted at **9:00 AM** within the Narayana Medical College campus to educate the public about the importance of Pulse Polio Immunization and to encourage maximum participation in the vaccination drive.

The rally was led by **Dr. G. Chandra Sekhar, Professor & Head, Department of Paediatrics**, along with **Dr. R. Sambasiva Reddy, Professor, Department of Paediatrics**, **Dr. P. Pratima, Professor, Department of Paediatrics**, and **Dr. D. M. Karthik, NSS Programme Officer**. During the rally, they emphasized the importance of timely immunization and explained how **Pulse Polio vaccination protects children from lifelong disability due to poliomyelitis**. They urged parents not to miss this opportunity, stressing that **every eligible child must receive the vaccine during every Pulse Polio round, irrespective of previous vaccination status**, to strengthen immunity and contribute towards a **Polio-Free India**.

A **Pulse Polio Immunization Booth** was established at the **General Hospital, Ground Floor, Narayana Medical College & Hospital**, where the **Oral Polio Vaccine was administered free of cost** to all eligible children below five years of age.

The awareness rally witnessed enthusiastic participation from **faculty members, postgraduate students, interns, nursing staff, NSS volunteers, students, and the college management**, making the programme a grand success.

The institution reaffirmed its commitment to supporting national public health initiatives and ensuring that **every child receives the protection they deserve through timely immunization**, thereby contributing to the vision of a **Polio-Free India**.
