Write-up on Ethics Awareness workshop for First-Year Postgraduate Students of 2026

A Workshop on Ethical Awareness for First-Year Postgraduate Students was successfully conducted on 8th April 2026 at BC Roy Lecture Gallery, Narayana Medical College, Nellore. The programme was organized in accordance with the directives of Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, making it mandatory for all postgraduate students as part of their academic requirements.

The workshop was conducted by Dr. V. Mahidhar Reddy, Professor and Head, Department of General Surgery, and Medical Education Unit Coordinator, who served as the resource faculty for the session. Dr.V.Krishna Chaitanya, PG Academic Cell incharge moderated the workshop.

The primary objective of the workshop was to sensitize newly joined postgraduate students to the importance of ethics, professionalism, attitudes, and communication in clinical practice. The session emphasized that ethical competence is as crucial as clinical knowledge and technical skills in delivering quality patient care.

The workshop covered key areas including:

- Fundamental principles of medical ethics such as autonomy, beneficence, non-maleficence, and justice
- Doctor-patient relationship and the importance of trust and empathy
- Informed consent and confidentiality in clinical practice
- Handling ethical dilemmas using real-life case scenarios
- Professional behavior, role modelling, and communication skills

Interactive case discussions were used effectively to engage participants and to illustrate the practical challenges faced in everyday clinical settings. The session highlighted common ethical conflicts encountered by postgraduate students and provided guidance on approaching them in a structured and patient-centered manner.

The workshop witnessed active participation from all first-year postgraduate students. The programme concluded successfully, achieving its objective of enhancing awareness and understanding of ethical principles among postgraduate students. A certificate of participation was issued to all attendees, which forms an essential requirement for their postgraduate academic progression.
