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REPORT ON WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY WEEK – 2026

The NSS Unit, Narayana College of Nursing, Nellore, observed **World Environment Day Week from 5th June 2026 to 10th June 2026** through a series of meaningful and environmentally responsible activities. The programme aimed to create awareness among students and staff regarding environmental protection, cleanliness, sustainable practices, responsible waste management, and the importance of individual participation in safeguarding the environment.

The activities were conducted in line with the **2026 World Environment Day theme, "Beat Plastic Pollution,"** which emphasizes collective action to reduce plastic pollution and promote sustainable and environmentally friendly practices.

The entire programme was **guided by Dr. B. Vanaja Kumari, Principal, Narayana College of Nursing, Nellore, and followed and coordinated by Mrs. S. Suchitra, NSS Programme Officer.** The active support and participation of faculty members, students, and staff contributed to the successful conduct of the various activities throughout the week.

DAY 1 – 5th June 2026

Plantation Programme – "Plant Today, Breathe Tomorrow"

The World Environment Day Week commenced on **5th June 2026** with a **Plantation Programme** on the college campus. Students and faculty members actively participated in planting saplings in the campus premises.

The programme highlighted the importance of trees in maintaining ecological balance, improving air quality, reducing environmental heat, conserving soil, and supporting biodiversity. Students were encouraged to consider each planted sapling as a **promise towards a greener and healthier future.**

The activity conveyed the inspiring message:

"Plant a tree today—not only for yourself, but for the generations yet to come."



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The plantation activity generated enthusiasm among students and encouraged them to take responsibility for caring for plants and maintaining a green campus.

DAY 2 – 6th June 2026

Swachh Bharat Activity – “Clean Campus, Green Campus”

On the second day, a **Swachh Bharat cleanliness activity** was organized within the college campus. Students and staff actively participated in cleaning designated areas and maintaining the surroundings in a neat and hygienic condition.

The activity focused on the importance of cleanliness, proper waste disposal, prevention of littering, and responsible use of public spaces. Students were sensitized to the fact that environmental protection begins with simple everyday actions such as **not littering, avoiding unnecessary plastic, segregating waste, and keeping our surroundings clean.**

The activity reinforced the message:

DAY 3 – 7th June 2026

Awareness Programme on the Importance of World Environment Day

DAY 4 – 8th June 2026

The session was conducted by **Ms. Swathi, Infection Control Department**, with the objective of strengthening awareness regarding safe, hygienic, and environmentally responsible waste handling practices.

The session covered important aspects of proper waste collection, segregation, handling, transportation, and disposal. Emphasis was placed on personal safety, prevention of exposure to hazardous waste, reduction of infection risks, and maintenance of a clean and safe working environment.

The programme highlighted that every person involved in maintaining cleanliness is an important **guardian of public health and environmental safety**. The participants were encouraged to consistently follow safe practices and appropriate protective measures while handling waste.

The session reinforced the message:

“Safe waste disposal protects the worker, the community, and the environment.”

DAY 5 – 9th June 2026

Eco-Friendly Activities by Students – “Small Actions, Big Impact”

The fifth day was dedicated to **eco-friendly activities by students**. Students actively participated in activities promoting environmentally responsible habits and sustainable living.

DAY 6 – 10th June 2026

Environmental Commitment – “Every Day is Environment Day”

The final day of the World Environment Day Week focused on reinforcing the environmental messages conveyed throughout the week. Students and faculty members reflected on the various activities conducted and discussed the importance of continuing environmentally responsible practices beyond the celebration.

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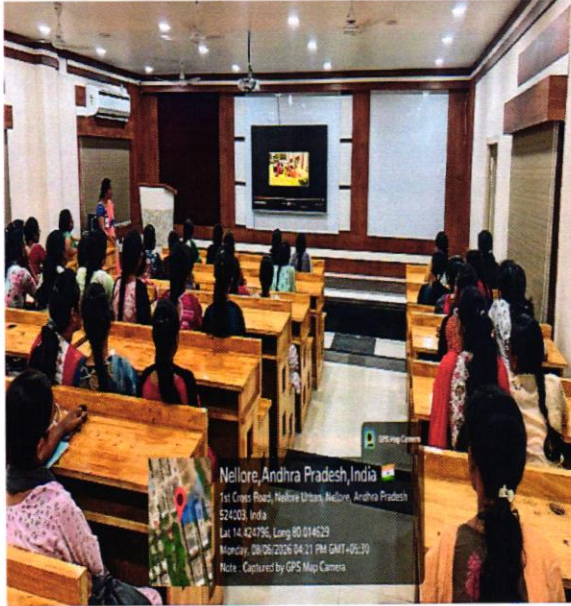

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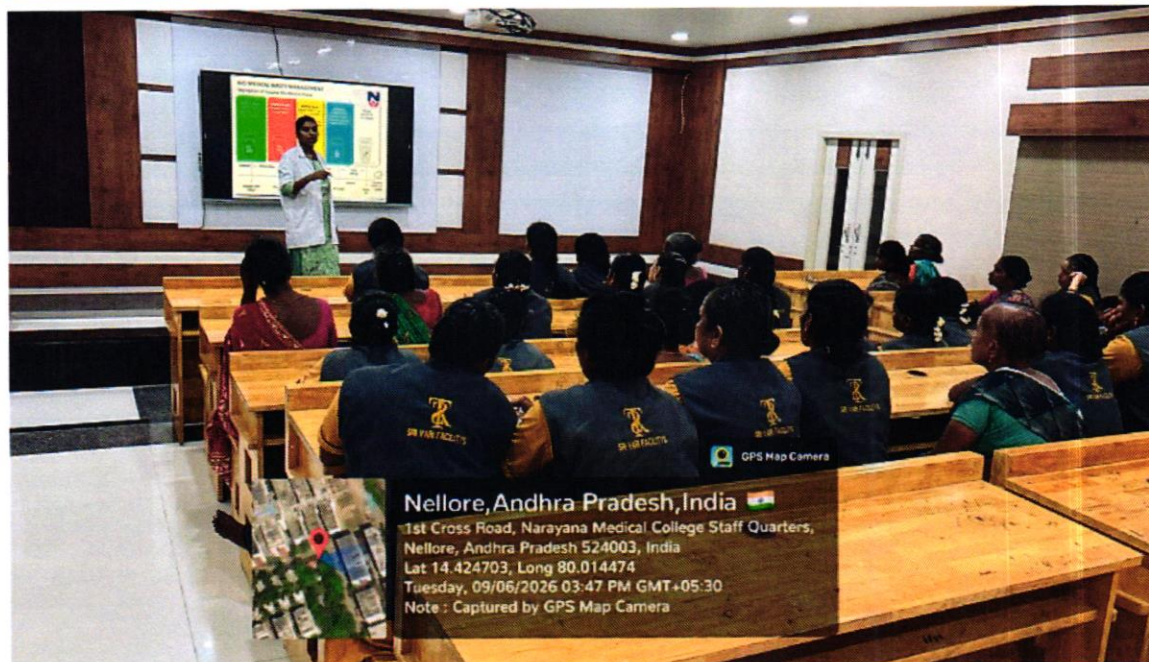
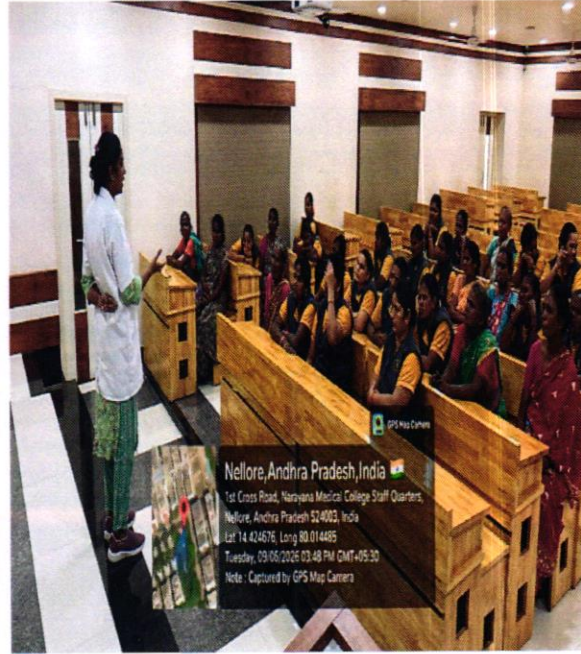
