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BLOOD DONAR DAY-14.6.2026

On 14 June 2026, a **Voluntary Blood Donation Camp** was organized at **Narayana General Hospital, Nellore**, by the **NSS Unit of Narayana College of Nursing** as part of the observance of **World Blood Donor Day 2026**. The programme was conducted with the theme **"Give Blood, Give Hope: Together We Save Lives,"** with the aim of creating awareness about the importance of voluntary blood donation, motivating eligible students to donate blood, and contributing towards maintaining an adequate and safe blood supply for patients in need.

The programme was inaugurated by the **Principal, Dr. B. Vanaja Kumari. Dr. Yashvardhan, Head of the Blood Bank**, and **Mrs. Suchitra, NSS Programme Officer**, addressed the gathering and highlighted the importance of voluntary blood donation. They explained that donated blood plays a vital role in saving the lives of patients during emergencies, accidents, surgeries, childbirth, and various medical conditions requiring blood transfusion. The students were encouraged to develop a sense of social responsibility and contribute towards community health through voluntary blood donation.

Prior to the camp, the NSS coordinators and volunteers created awareness among the students regarding the importance of blood donation and motivated eligible students to participate voluntarily. Students who had examinations were not included in the blood donation activity so that their academic commitments were not affected. The willing participants were registered and underwent the required preliminary health assessment and donor screening before blood donation.

A total of **14 students voluntarily donated blood** during the camp and contributed towards this noble and life-saving cause. Appropriate safety measures and infection-control procedures were followed throughout the blood donation process. The donors were monitored during and after donation, and necessary guidance was provided regarding post-donation care. After donating blood, the participants were provided with refreshments and adequate rest. **Appreciation**



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certificates were distributed to the blood donors in recognition of their valuable contribution and humanitarian service.

The NSS volunteers played an active role in the successful conduct of the programme by mobilizing eligible students, creating awareness, assisting with registration, guiding donors, maintaining discipline, and coordinating the activities of the camp. Faculty members, students, and NSS volunteers actively participated and extended their cooperation throughout the programme. Their collective efforts helped to create a positive attitude towards voluntary blood donation and encouraged students to understand their responsibility towards society.

The Blood Donation Camp successfully promoted awareness about voluntary blood donation and emphasized the importance of donating blood to support patients in need. The participation of **14 student donors** demonstrated the spirit of compassion, community service, and social responsibility among the students of Narayana College of Nursing. The programme was successfully completed with the cooperation and support of the Principal, Blood Bank team, faculty members, NSS coordinators, NSS volunteers, students, and all the voluntary blood donors. 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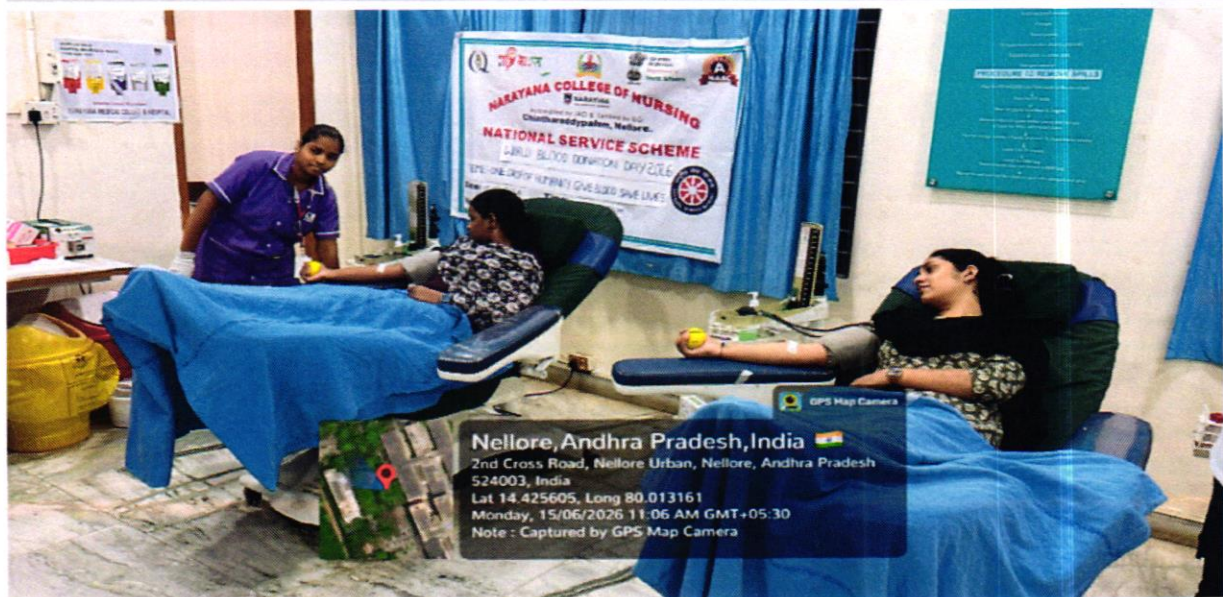
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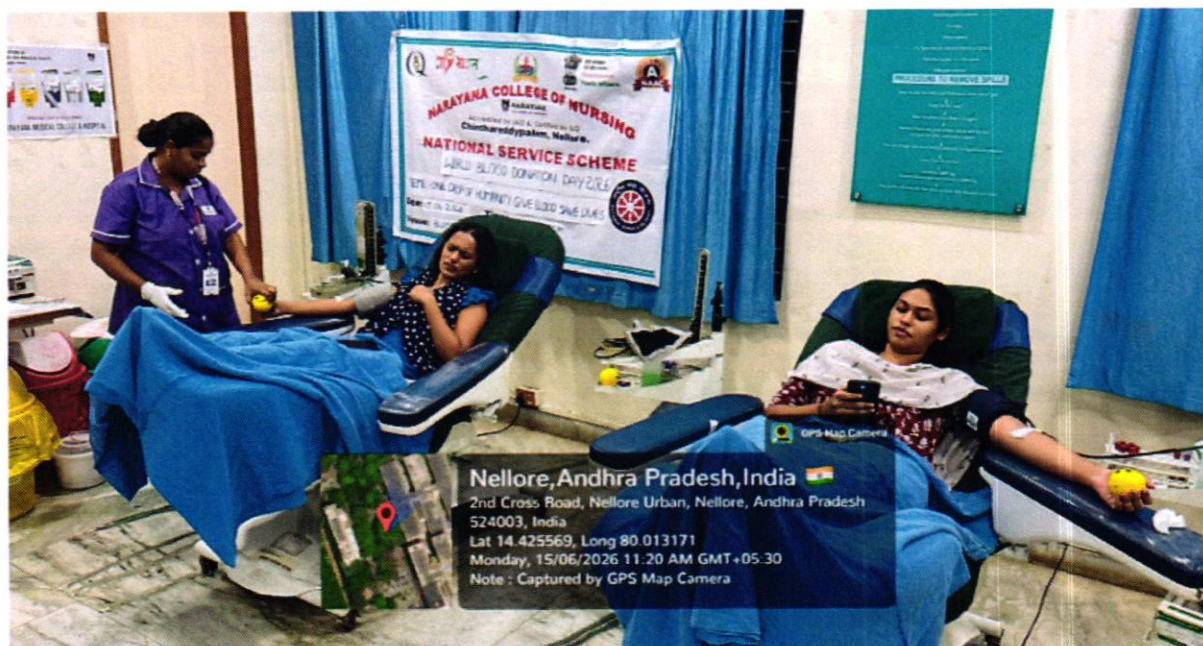
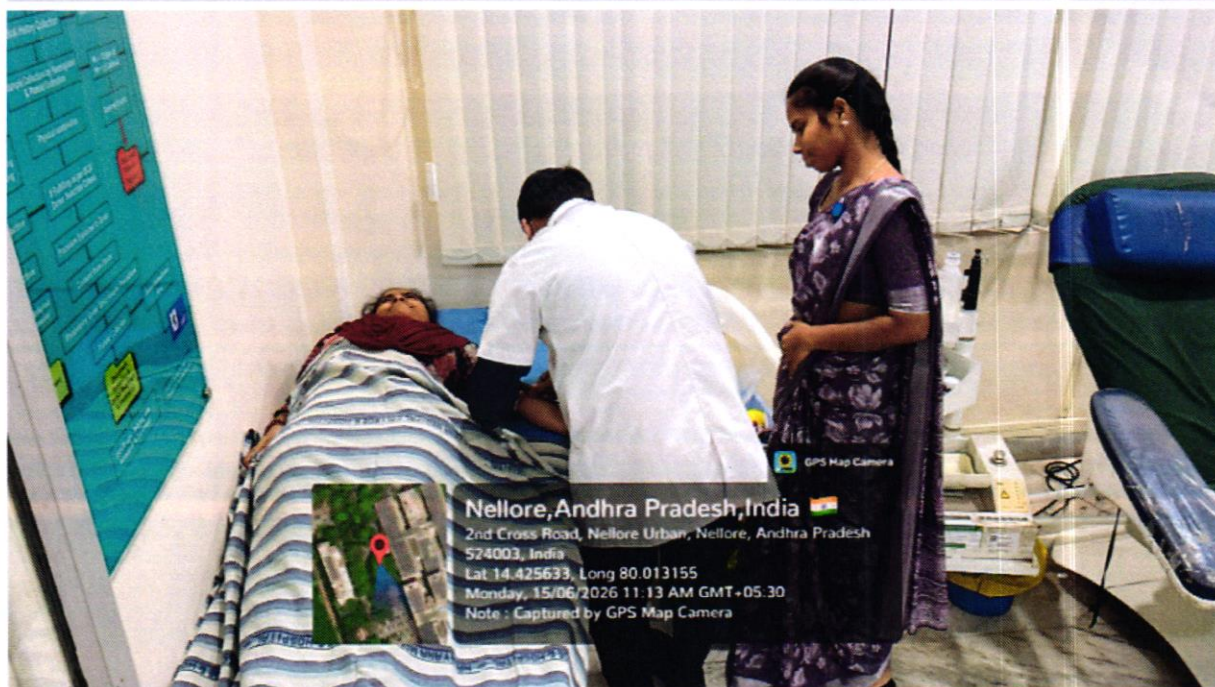
