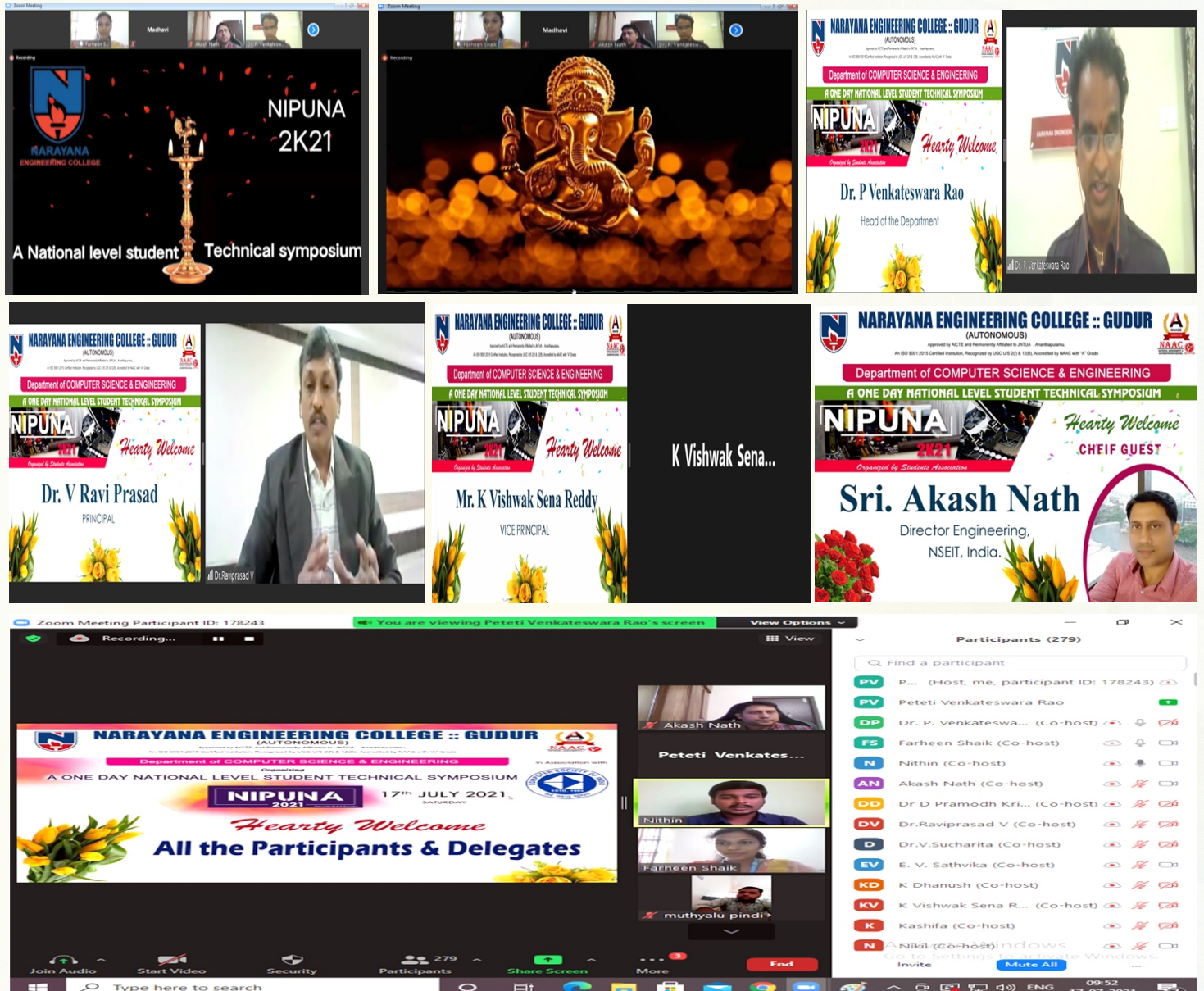

PROJECT EXPO

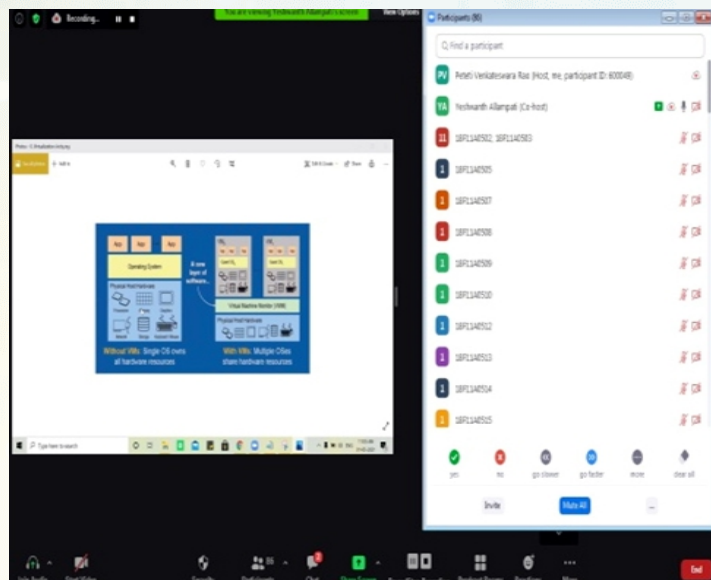
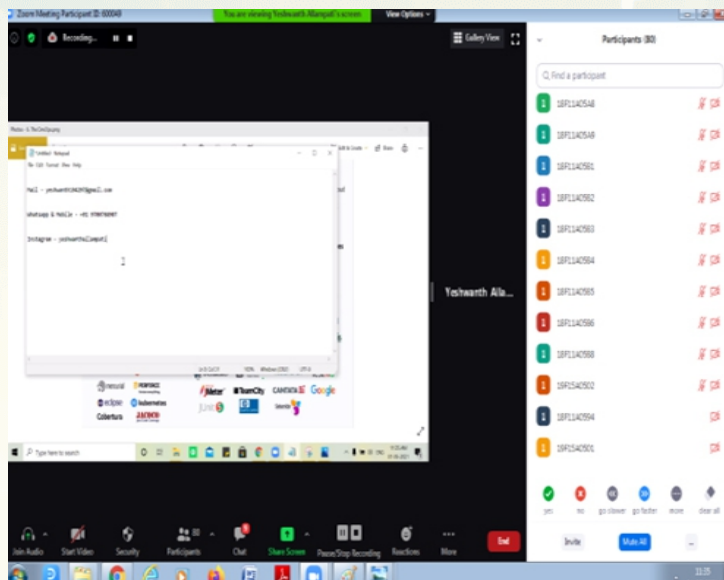

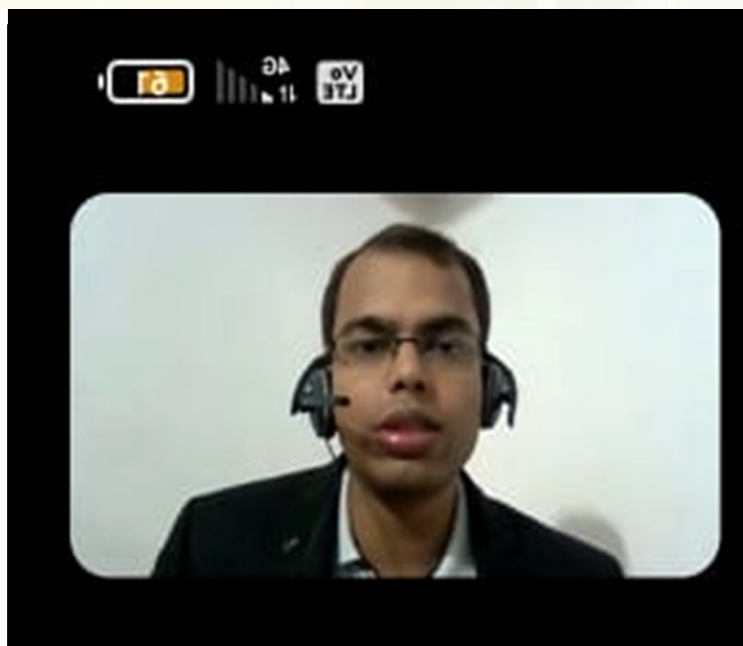
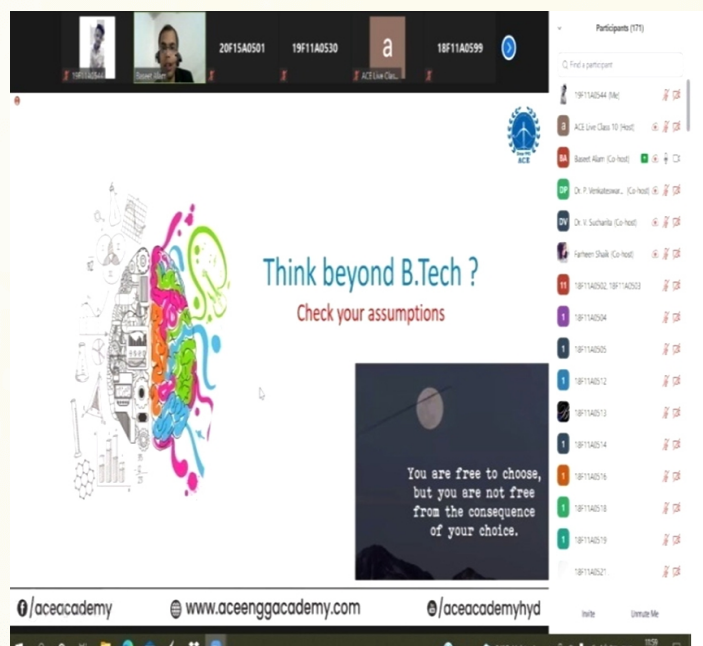
A Webinar on Roles of DevOps in Cloud Computing Environment

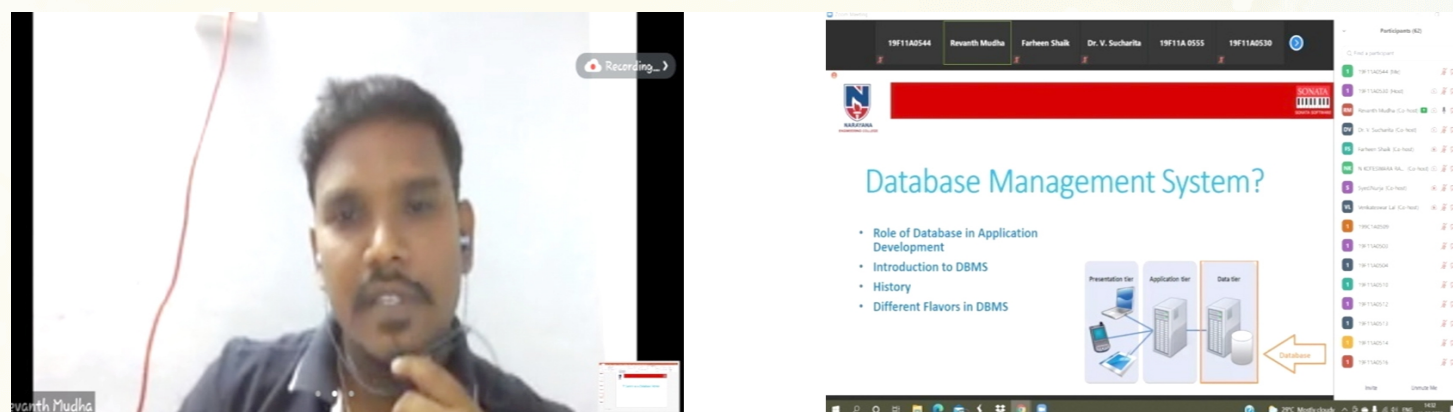
Webinar on Dental Caries and Its Prevention for Women under Women's Forum of CSE

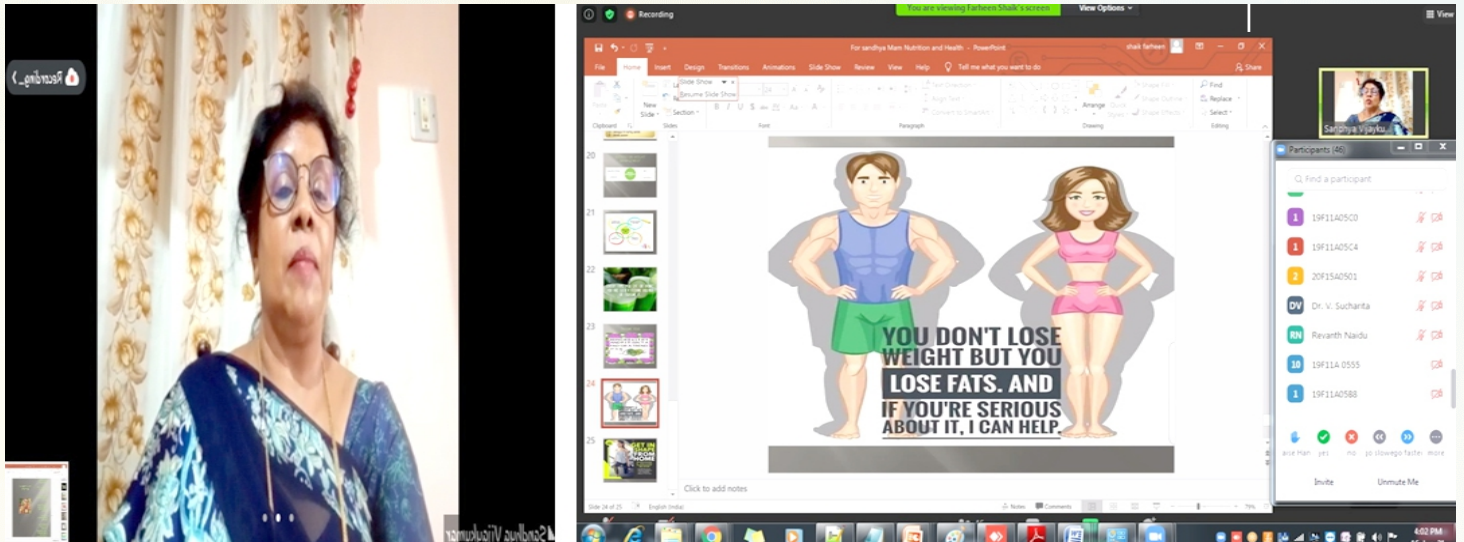
A Webinar on Database Administration-An Overview - Seminars

Webinar on Nutritional Health for Women

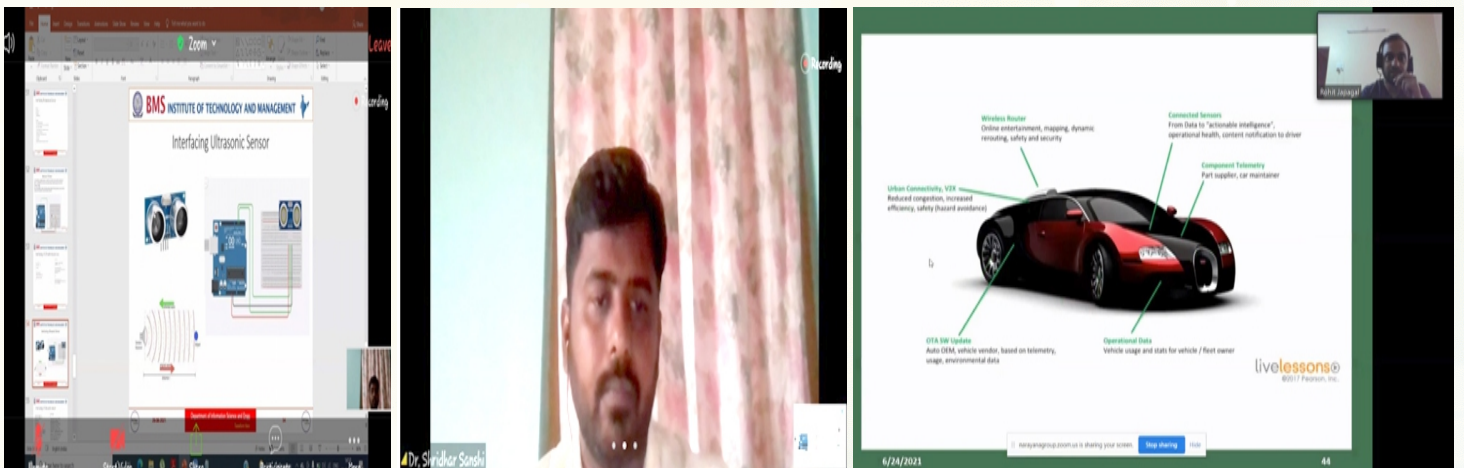

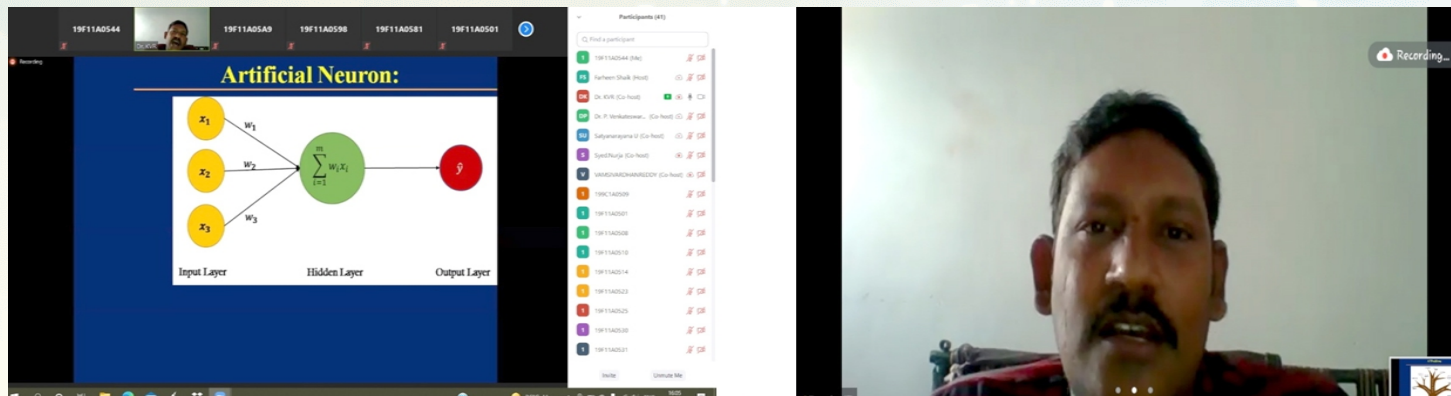
A One week Workshop on Competitive Coding using Hacker Rank

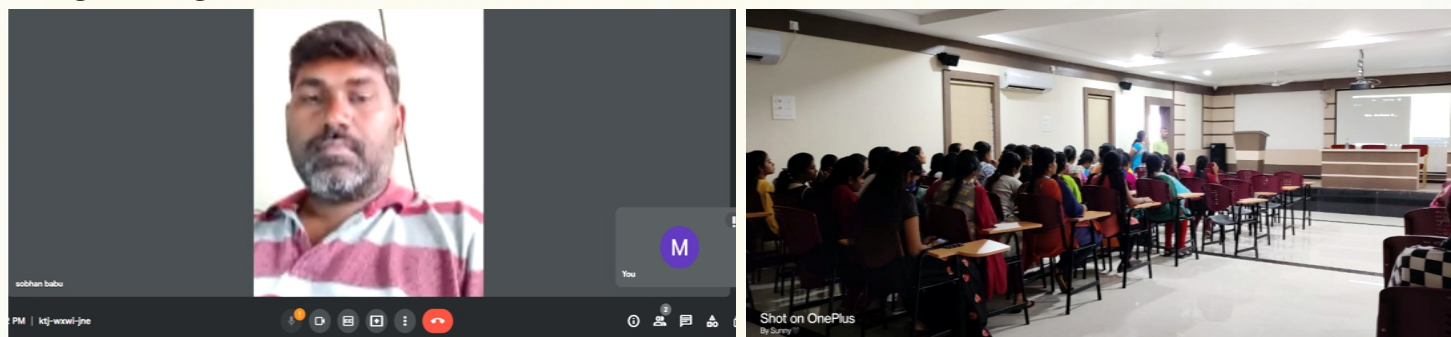
Webinar on Artificial Neural Networks Under CSI

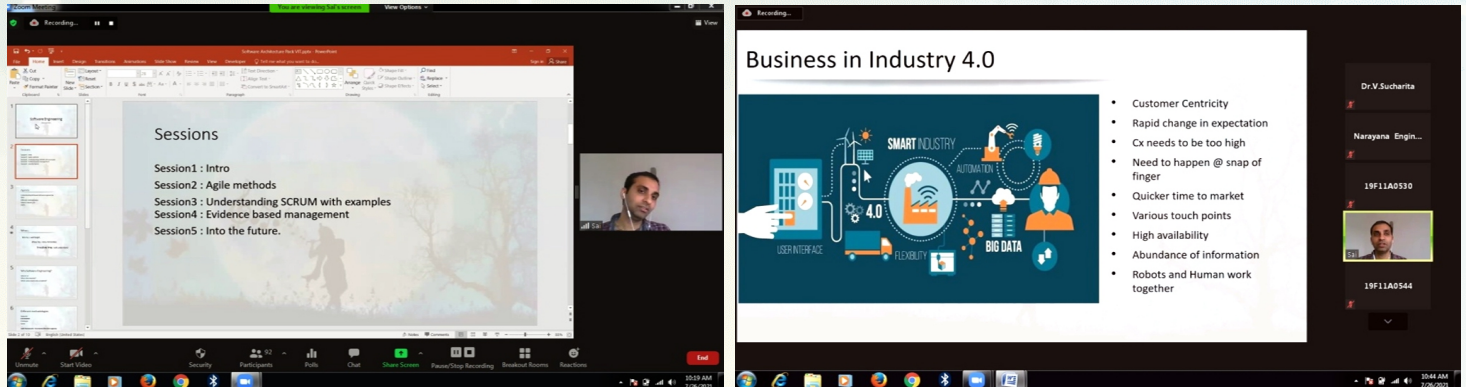
GUEST TALK ON ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE & IT'S JOURNEY

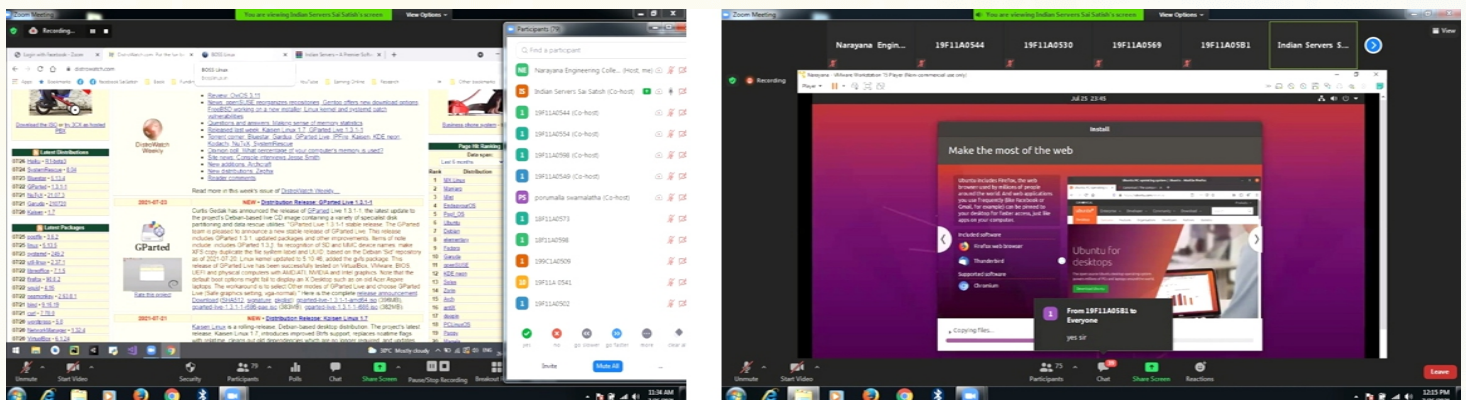
A Guest Talk on Software Engineering
