REPORT:

A one-day awareness program on first aid was organized by the NSS Unit of Mechanical Department on 10th September, 2022. The principal sir asked the students, what their first instinct would be, if they happened to see a victim. The various answers

included stop bleeding, managing the crowd, trying to prevent unconsciousness, reassuring the victim things would be fine, informing the family and calling the ambulance. This was aptly followed by the explanation about the Chain of Survival. This chain includes steps, which should be followed in the order mentioned, at any cost. Early ambulance, Early CPR (Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation), Early AED (Automated External Defibrillator), and Effective ALS (Advanced Life Support), Post Cardiac Care. The second and the most important step of the procedure involve keeping the victim conscious, and these are the ABCs to be kept in mind – Air, Breathing and Circulation. Preserving life is the primary objective of doing first aid. This involves making sure that the injury is not a life-threatening one for the individual. It also involves calling ambulances as soon as possible and also performing CPR in extreme circumstances. Someone who is trained in first aid should check for vital life signs as well, to see if an injury is life-threatening. These signs include evidence of breathing, movement, responsiveness, heart rate, and any bad external injuries. 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
