Report on Helping Hands-Food Distribution to Flood Victims

REPORT: The distribution took place on 08-SEP-2024 at Rajarajeswari Pet, where many flood victims had taken temporary shelter. Our team coordinated with local authorities to identify the areas with the greatest need and ensure that the supplies reached the most affected people. The Vijayawada floods of 2024 was a major disaster that affected thousands of lives. However, thanks to his team of five members, the worst impacts were mitigated.

Their contributions, including the distribution of essential items like milk, bread, towels, and mosquito nets, helped bring relief to many displaced families. As the city begins the process of recovery, continued support from volunteers and organizations remains crucial. Our modest contribution helped approximately 50 families in the affected area. We were able to provide them with basic food supplies and protection from mosquitoes, which will help in preventing diseases like dengue and malaria during this time.

The flood situation in Vijayawada requires continued efforts from individuals, organizations, and the government. Our team was able to make a small but significant contribution to those affected by the floods. We hope that our initiative inspires more people to come forward and help in rebuilding lives and restoring normalcy for the victims.
